



Troop 109 Leadership Position Description

PATROL GRUBMASTER

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Type:** Appointed by the Patrol Leader
Term: 6 months
Reports to: Patrol Leader
Description: The Patrol Grubmaster assures that the patrol has the necessary food on a campout.
Comments: The Patrol Grubmaster follows the Patrol's menu plan, and works within the budget provided to assure that there is sufficient food on the weekend campout.

QUALIFICATIONS

- Age:** 11 or older
Rank: None
Experience: None – this is an entry level position.
Attendance: Normal Troop standards
Participation: Fundraisers & Service Projects

PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS

- Training:** None required.
Attendance: You are expected to attend 50% of all troop meetings, outings, and service projects. If your attendance is low, you can be removed from office.
Effort: You are expected to give this job your best effort.

GENERAL LEADERSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES

- Uniform:** Set the example by wearing your uniform correctly. This means that you will wear all of the parts of the troop uniform, shirttail tucked in, with all required badges in their correct locations.
Behavior: Set the example by living the Scout Oath and Law in your everyday life. Show Scout Spirit in everything you say and do.
Attendance: Set the example by being an active Scout. Be on time for meetings and activities. You must call the Senior Patrol Leader or Scoutmaster if you are not going to be at a meeting or if you suddenly have to miss an outing. You also need to make sure that you fulfill your responsibilities, **EVEN IF YOU ARE NOT GOING ON THAT MONTH'S CAMPOUT..**

SPECIFIC LEADERSHIP RESPONSIBILITIES

- Shops and compares prices
- Purchases only the items that support your patrol's menu (condiments not required)
- Spends the least amount of money possible for the food (a scout is thrifty)
- Pays the cashier and collects the correct change
- Returns the receipt with any unused money to the Troop Treasurer
- Brings food on campout – supplies own cooler for perishables and uses patrol crate for non-perishables
- If not attending campout, makes arrangements with Patrol Leader for the food to be brought on the campout
- Bring home leftover non-perishables for use at next campout
